SUGGESTED CLOTHING LIST FOR NEW ADMISSION

FEMALE

Please ensure that all clothing is machine washable if the Home is to care for the clothing. All items must be labelled.

- two housecoats
- two pair of slippers (non-slip sole)
- one pair of shoes
- six pair of socks (acrylic) no tight elastic at top
- two pair of stockings/stay-ups
- five nightgowns/pyjamas
- six dresses (washable) and/or slacks/shorts/tops/jogging suits
- two sweaters (washable)
- glasses, hearing aide, dentures (NB. marked with name)
- six changes of underwear
- three slips
- six changes of bras and/or undershirts
- cosmetics/costume jewelry
- hat

If the resident is able and allowed to go outside, please include minimal outdoor clothing (ie. hat, coat, gloves and boots).

Please ensure that all clothing is machine washable if the facility is to wash the clothing. All items must be labelled.

- one dressing gown
- one pair of shoes (eg. running shoes with Velcro closures, fiat with sturdy support) NB: washable shoes are preferred
- one pair of slippers (non-slip sole)
- four pairs of pyjamas
- six undershirts
- six changes of underpants
- six pairs of socks (acrylic) no tight elastic at top
- six pairs of trousers (washable) and/or jogging suits
- six shirts
- two sweaters (washable)
- one belt or pair of suspenders
- one hairbrush
- one toothbrush
- one comb
- one razor (NB: if electric, please mark with name)
- glasses, hearing aide, dentures (NB: marked with name)
- hat
